##### Traditional Heritage Day Fete

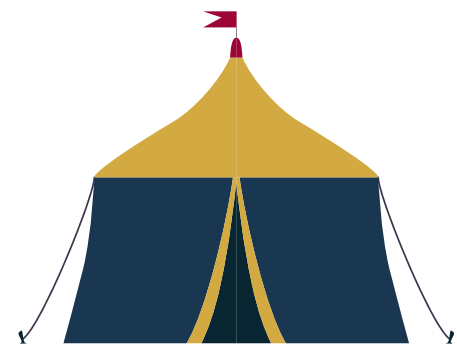
A traditional school fete hosted by Sorell School primary students. Each class is responsible for a different stall.

Aboriginal perspective of 200 year. Collaborative arts project. Led by Sorell students and Alan Wagin.

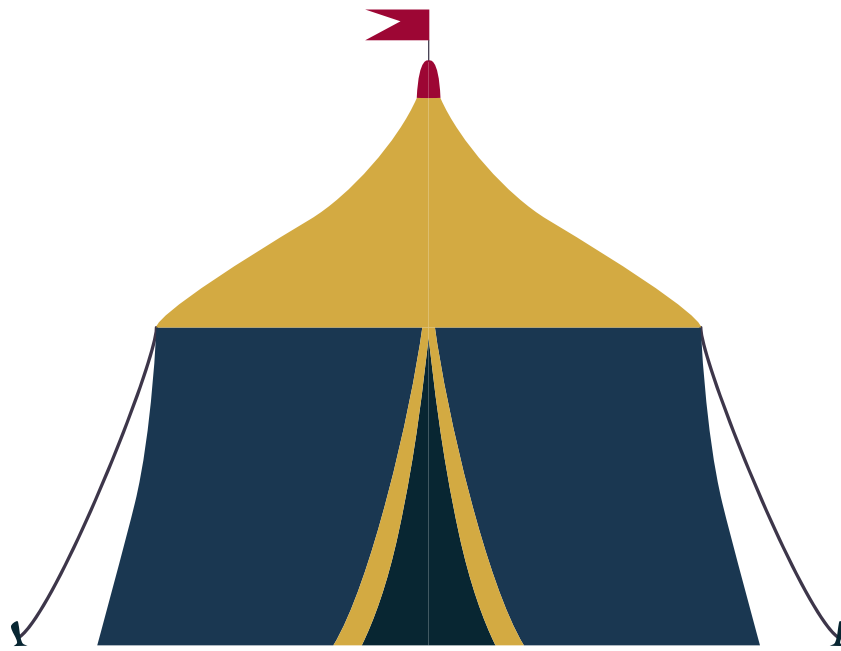
